### Solar Feed in Rate / Tariff

DE Standard Rate	Customers with eligible Solar-PV systems will receive 8 cents/kWh for all export electricity (net metered only), subject to change as per the relevant Terms & Conditions with at least the minimum Government Regulated rate being payable as applicable. The DE Standard Rate applies to solar-PV systems up to 10kW capacity or as otherwise approved.
Distributor Tariff	Eligible customers under the NSW Solar Bonus Scheme will receive either 20 cents/export kWh or 60 cents/export kWh as applicable until scheme payments close on 31 <sup>st</sup> December 2016.
