

The Retailer Energy Productivity Scheme (REPS) is a South Australian Government program that provides incentives to help households and businesses reduce their energy consumption, lower costs, and cut emissions, with energy retailers delivering approved efficiency and productivity activities each year.

How does it work?

Obligated energy retailers, including Diamond Energy, are required to achieve their Energy Productivity Targets by undertaking energy productivity activities.

What is available?

Here are some examples of energy productivity activities that may be available through our accredited activity provider [MAC Trade Services](#) to eligible South Australian households and businesses.

For households:

- Installing an efficient new reverse cycle air conditioner
- Connecting a battery to a Virtual Power Plant (VPP)
- Replacing or upgrading a water heater
- Installing an energy efficient appliance
- Installing energy efficient lighting

For small businesses¹:

- Installing an efficient new reverse cycle air conditioner
- Replacing or upgrading a water heater
- Installing an energy efficient appliance
- installing energy efficient lighting

For large businesses²:

- Installing energy efficient lighting
- Installing a high efficiency refrigerated display cabinet
