Feed-in Tariff: Distributor Funded PFIT Scheme is closed to new solar-PV installations. Existing Solar-PV installations receiving PFIT will continue to

do so as per scheme rules and where they maintain eligibility. DE Standard Rate will also apply to increase feed

in rate to 72 cents/kWh for eligible PFIT participants.

DE Standard Rate Customers with eligible Solar-PV systems will receive 12 cents/kWh for all export electricity (net metered only)

subject to change as per the relevant Terms & Conditions. DE Standard Rate applies to solar-PV systems up to

10kW or as otherwise agreed in writing by us.
